Public Disclosure of Student Achievement Goals and Outcomes for the Parker University

Parker University evaluates success with respect to student achievement consistent with Parker's mission. In a commitment to continuously improve student success, Parker University established a *Turning Point 5-year University Strategic Plan 2014/15-2019/20* approved by the Board of Trustees on December 2013.
