Behind the scenes of businesses, government agencies, and health care organizations across the world, the need for more business-oriented tech specialists has become increasingly clear.

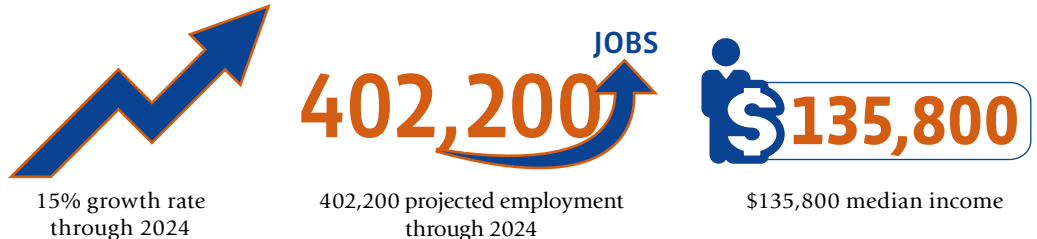

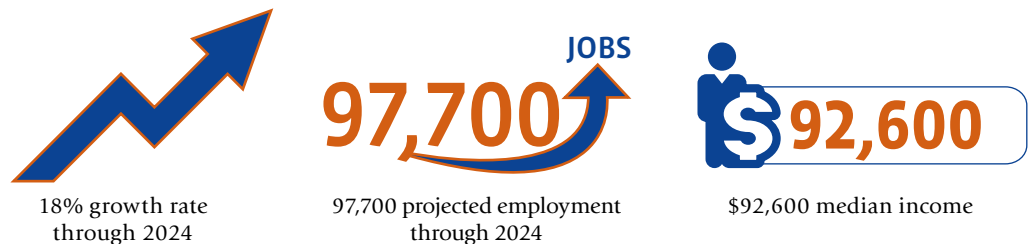
