The Master of Public Health prepares students to address the field of public health utilizing education, community service, and research. Public health practitioners are prepared to plan, implement, and evaluate programs designed to meet the health needs of populations, utilizing knowledge basic to public health, including biostatistics, epidemiology, environmental health sciences, social and behavioral sciences, and health services administration. This program also provides students with field experience and an opportunity to apply their knowledge through the Applied Practice Experience and the Integrative Learning Experience.

WHY A MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH DEGREE?

The public health field is a unique area of study providing many professional job opportunities for those who enjoy helping others. Public health combines different academic areas for a multidisciplinary approach to the healthcare field. This program gives graduates a broad range of healthcare career opportunities including creating public health policies, developing medical care programs, and analyzing health statistics or working in communities educating about ways to stay healthy. Besides helping at the community level, public health professionals can be involved in worldwide policy initiatives.
