Professional Licensure

Parker University requires students to take the American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS) Sonography Principles & Instrumentation (SPI) exam in addition to attempting the Cardiac Credentialing International (CCI) exam. Passing the SPI and attempting the CCI is a requirement of graduation. Upon successful completion of the SPI and CCI exam, students will be eligible to sit for the ARDMS exam.

Accreditation
